

# PORTUGAL EXPELS JESUITS.

Closes a Monastery and Warns the  
Inmates Not to Return.

LISBON, Sept. 14.—The monastery of the Spanish Jesuits, at Aldeia-Ponte has been closed by a Government decree, and the Jesuits have been expelled from the country. They are warned that if they return to Portugal they will be arrested.

The Monarchists of the Opposition to-day protested the selection of twenty-six members of the Government Party. Parliament will not be convened until these contests are decided.
